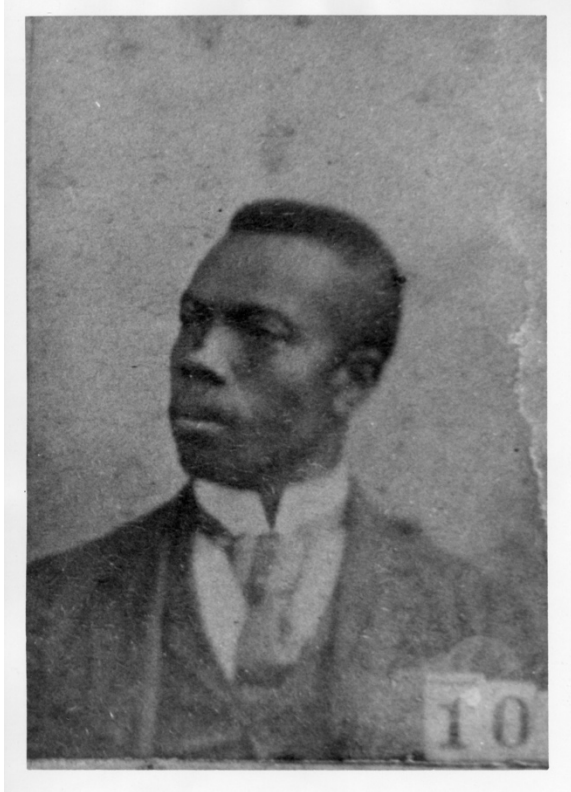

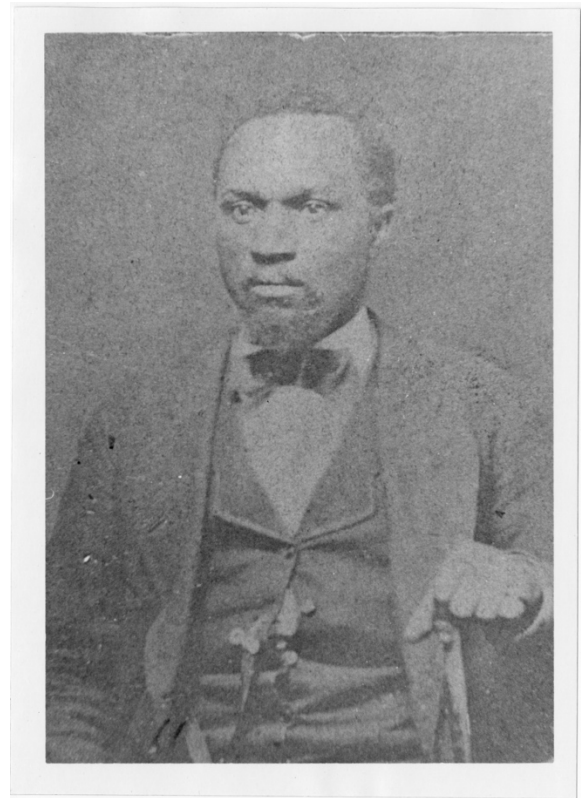

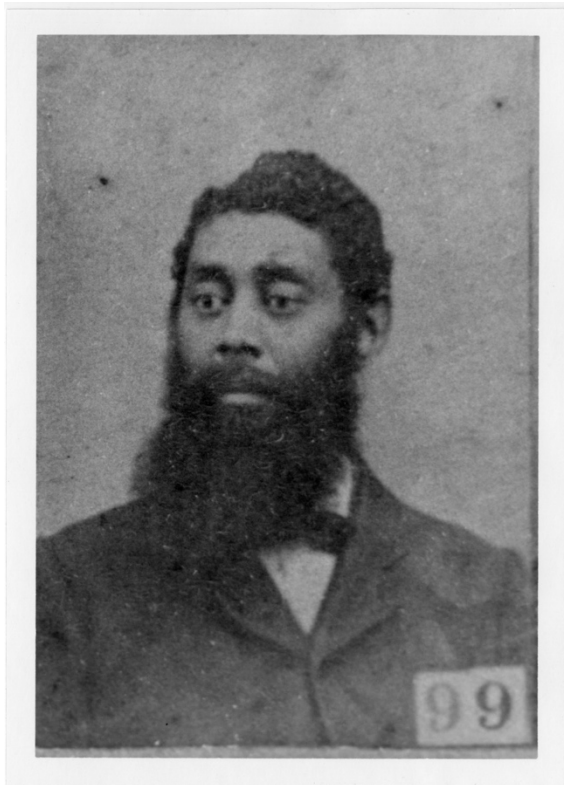


Photo 3: Henry A. Johnson,

collection, ca. 1890-1954)

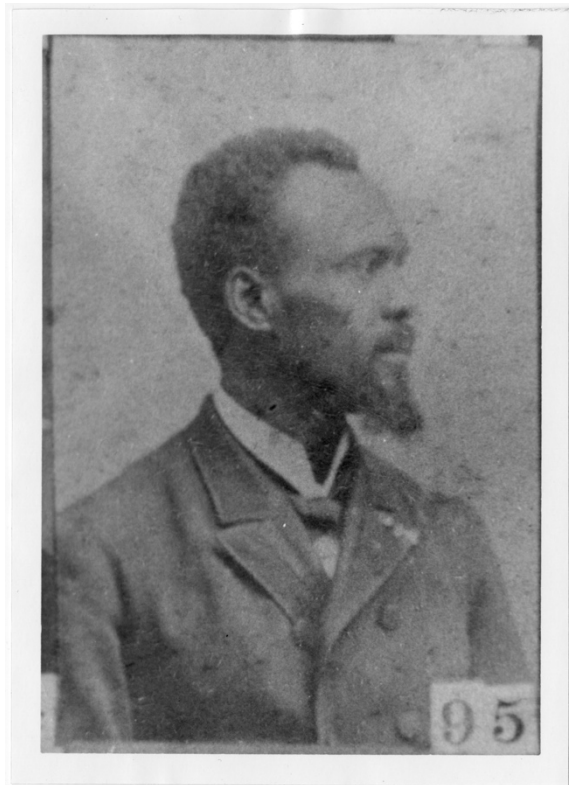


Photo 4: George W. Lowe,

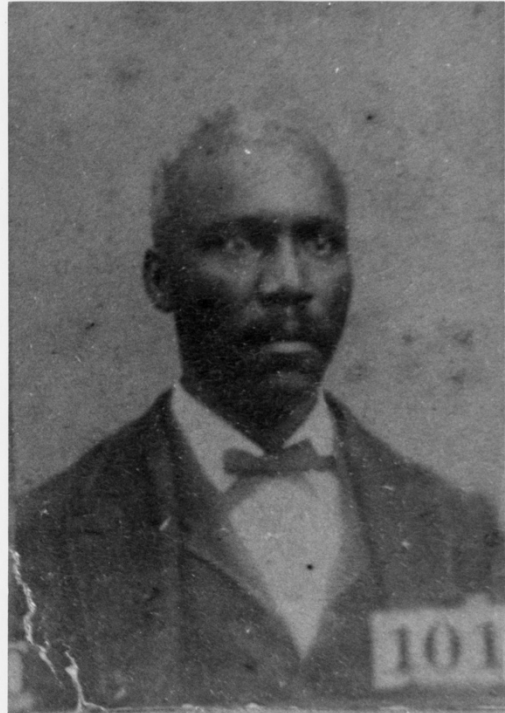
