TRANSCRIPTION

We the undersigned citizens of the County of Crawford & State of Arkansas do agree to form ourselves into a Volunteer Military Company to be known as the "Van Buren Frontier Guards" for the purpose of instructing ourselves in the Art of War and if necessary for our domestic defense; and we hereby bind ourselves to submit to the laws and regulations of this Company as administered by the proper officers, to be prompt[?] in our attendance on duty and do every thing in our power to promote the prosperity of the Company and maintain its permanent organization
