edge of wood of
Bardicourt. Many
Germans just beyond.

Spent tonight in
Bois de Perivicourt.
November 2nd.

Had very hard
fight coming out
of woods. Many
machine gunners.
Many killed. But
we came out just
the same. I was
on the right flank.
Lost many men.
6300 hrs. Haze got to take a

hill, manned by M.S.
 14.00 Hr. Have taken hill
 made a grand
 charge up it.
 • No night & a wild
 one. Lost 2nd Officer.

November 3rd.

on hill 1 Km. S.
 Gailly, 355 relieved
 us.

November 4 still
 on hill.

November 5th.

At it again.
