

- 8** Type of steamboat used for entertainment.
- 10** Steamboat deck named after a Southern state -- the pilot house usually sits on this top deck.
- 13** Steamboats were used in battles during this conflict.
- 16** Replaced steamboats for long-distance transportation.
- 18** Famous American author who wrote about life as a steamboat pilot.
- 19** River navigation system opened in Arkansas in 1968.
- 20** A United States president that owned four Frederick T. Anderson paintings.
- 21** Watercolor artist from southeast Arkansas.
- 23** Steamboat involved in the worst maritime disaster in U. S. history.

- 1** The steamboat machinery allegedly responsible for the sinking of Sultana.
- 3** Popular mode of transportation during the 1800's.
- 4** The process of forcing Native Americans to move westward during the 1830's.
- 5** Type of commercial steamboat refitted with metal plates for protection during the Civil War.
- 7** The twentieth century's largest steam towboat on the Mississippi River.
- 9** Type of steamboat that plucked hazardous, submerged logs out of rivers for improved ship navigation.
- 11** The Memphis cemetery where Frederick T. Anderson is buried.
- 12** A type of animal native to southeastern United States and allegedly kept as a pet by Sultana's captain.
- 14** The famous steamboat that arrived in New Orleans from Pittsburg in 1812.
- 15** Steam powered musical instrument featuring organ pipes.
- 17** The first steamboat to arrive in Arkansas at Arkansas Post in 1820.
- 22** Musical style made famous by trumpeter Louis Armstrong and often played on steamboats in the twentieth and twenty-first centuries.
